До собеседования

Подготовка является ключом к успешному собеседованию на получение визы. Следующие шаги помогут вам в эффективной подготовке:

Убедитесь, что у вас есть все необходимые документы на собеседование, включая:

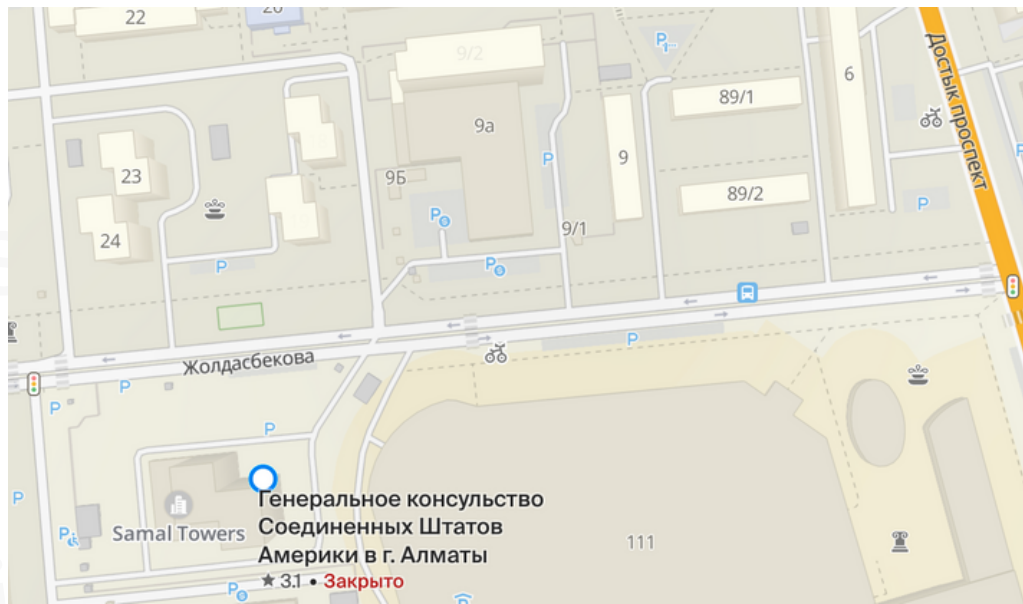
- 1) **Действительный паспорт**
- 2) **Зачетная книжка или оригинал транскрипта за весь период обучения**
- 3) **Студенческий билет (Student ID Card)**

**Подачей документов на собеседование, организацией оплаты консульского сбора для прохождения собеседования, записью на собеседование занимается непосредственно ваше агенство по программе.*

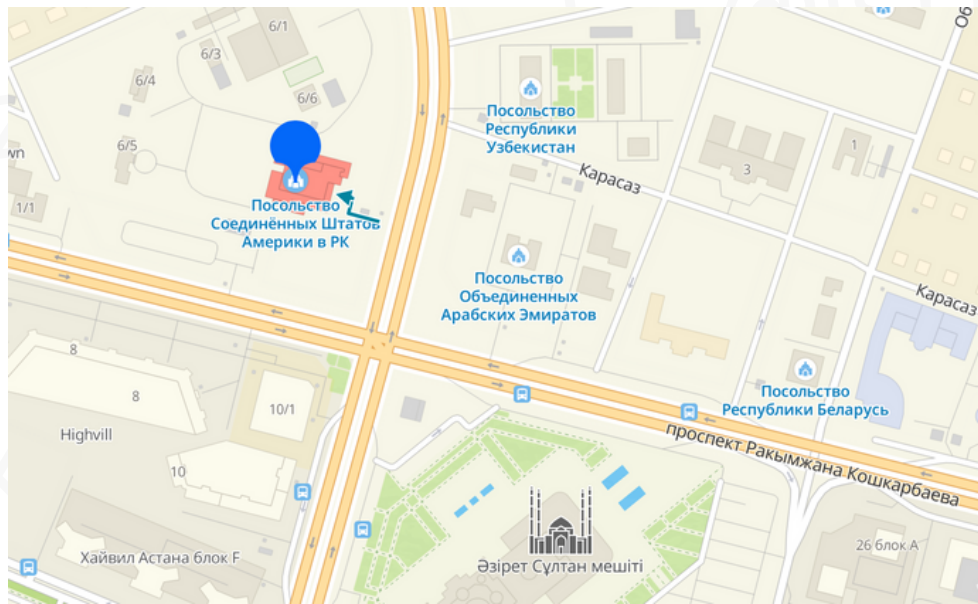
Важной частью вашего заявления на визу J-1 является процесс собеседования. Сотрудник консульства задаст вопросы, чтобы определить ваше право на получение визы. Подготовка является ключом к уверенному ответу на вопросы. Вот несколько распространенных вопросов и советов о том, как подготовить свои ответы. А также на **следующих страницах** вы сможете просмотреть список наиболее встречающихся вопросов на собеседовании в посольстве.

До собеседования

Прибытие в посольство - будьте пунктуальными, приезжайте за **15-20 минут** до назначенного времени!

Внешний вид - наденьте удобную, повседневную одежду. Не нужно стараться впечатлить консула праздничными нарядами и украшениями. Стоит пренебречь яркими и политическими надписями на одежде. Основное время ожидания своей очереди будет на улице, так что учтите погодные условия.



Собеседование

Собеседование обычно длится не долго и разговор ведется через окошко, похожее на кассу в банках, со специальным аудио устройством. Будьте вежливыми, поздоровайтесь.



Основные темы вопросов

Why do you want to participate in the J-1 Program?

Объясните причины вашего участия в программе, сосредоточив внимание на культурном обмене, возможностях получения образования или профессиональном развитии. Уточните, что вы надеетесь получить и как это согласуется с вашими карьерными или академическими целями.

What are your plans after completing the J-1 Program?

Обсудите свои планы по применению того, чему вы научитесь в США, в вашей будущей учебе или карьере на родине. Это показывает ваше намерение вернуться, что является важным требованием.

Can you describe the program you will be participating in?

Четко излагайте детали вашей программы, включая ее цели, виды деятельности и то, как она вписывается в ваш общий образовательный или карьерный путь. Знание специфики демонстрирует вашу приверженность программе и понимание ее сути.

Do you have any ties to your home country?

Этот вопрос оценивает ваше намерение вернуться домой. Укажите семью, собственность, предложения о работе или продолжающуюся учебу, которые требуют от вас возвращения. Прочные связи с вашей родной страной работают в вашу пользу.

Have you traveled to the U.S. before?

Подробно опишите цель ваших предыдущих визитов и убедитесь, что вы четко соблюдали условия ваших предыдущих виз. Если нет, просто укажите, что это будет ваш первый опыт пребывания в США, который вы с нетерпением ожидаете для образовательного и культурного обмена.

How will this program benefit your career or studies?

Свяжите программу с вашими планами на будущее. Объясните, как приобретенные вами навыки, знания или опыт будут применены в вашей карьере или академической деятельности на родине.

- **What is your name?**

- "My name is Kuanysh Abikeev."

- **Why do you want to go to the USA?**

- "My primary reason for wanting to visit the USA is to participate in the Work and Travel program, which I believe is a unique opportunity to gain international work experience and cultural exchange. Additionally, I've always been fascinated by the diverse landscapes and cultural landmarks the US has to offer. During my stay, I hope to have the chance to visit iconic sites like Niagara Falls and experience the vibrant energy of cities like Las Vegas. These experiences will not only enrich my understanding of American culture but also provide me with memories and insights to bring back home."
- "I'm eager to go to the USA not only for the invaluable work experience and cultural exchange the Work and Travel program offers but also to fulfill my dream of attending live concerts by some of my favorite American artists. The US is home to a vibrant music scene, and attending concerts in genres I love would be a dream come true. - **What job are you going to have in the US?**

- "I'll be working as a sales assistant at a retail store in Rehoboth Beach, Delaware. It's a seasonal position that aligns with my summer break."

- **How will this experience help you in your future?**

- "This experience will improve my English language proficiency, teach me valuable interpersonal skills, and provide insight into American culture, all of which are essential for my future career in international business."

- **Do you have brothers or sisters?**

- "Yes, I have one younger sister who is in high school. We are very close, and I look forward to sharing my experiences in the U.S. with her."

- **Have you ever been abroad? Where? When?**

- "Yes, I participated in a short educational program in Turkey last year. It was a great opportunity to experience a new culture and improve my language skills."

- **Where do your parents work?**

- "My father is an engineer at a local firm, and my mother is a teacher at a high school in Astana."

- **Where do you study and what is your major?**

- "I am a second-year student at Nazarbayev University, majoring in International Business."

Факторы положительно влияющие на одобрение визы

- Высокий GPA
- Хороший уровень владения английским языком
- Уверенная и поставленная речь
- Отсутствие родственников в США
- Отсутствие опыта участия в программе
- Сильная мотивация вернуться обратно по окончании программы
- При имеющихся въездах в США, соблюдение сроков по выезду из США согласно полученной визе.

Факторы по которым у консула могут возникнуть вопросы

- Низкий GPA
 - Имея низкий средний показатель успеваемости будьте готовы объяснить причину сложившейся ситуации. Приведите разумные аргументы повлиявшие на спад ваших оценок. Если в период обучения ваш GPA увеличился стоит отметить свой прогресс во время интервью.
- Повторный участник программы SWT
 - Важно отметить везкие причины почему вам снова необходимо участвовать, показать сильную мотивацию вернуться обратно.
- Родственник находится в США
 - Если это не мама, папа, брат/сестра, то не нужно говорить что есть родственники в США.
- Неуверенная речь, плохой английский
 - Не переживайте, заранее подготовьте примерные ответы на самые популярные вопросы. Отвечайте хоть и коротко, но уверенно и по делу.





Успешные кейсы интервью (Approved)

Officer: Hello, what is your name?

Student: Hello! My name is Aidina Sabyrova.

Officer: How old are you?

Student: I'm twenty years old.

Officer: What is your major?

Student: I study mathematics at the Nazarbayev University.

Officer: Which year student are you?

Student: I'm a second year student.

Officer: What do you plan to do in the USA?

Student: Excuse me? Do you mean my work?

Officer: Yes, what is your job?

Student: I'm planning to be a floor attendant in New Jersey, North Wildwood. My responsibilities are to assist customers with any questions and keep assigned areas clean.

Officer: What do you plan to do after you graduate?

Student: After I graduate in my university, I'm planning to apply for masters program either in Data Science or Education.

Officer: And after that?

Student: I plan to work in Kazakhstan because I need to provide my parents, they're quite old.

Officer: What do your parents do?

Student: My mother is a self-employed baker and my father works in an oil company as a finance director.

Officer: What is your father's income?

Student: Actually, I don't know. But still, we have enough income since my father provides his 4 children with everything they need.

Officer: So, you have brothers and sisters?

Student: Yes, I have two elderly brothers and one younger sister.

Officer: Do you know this pamphlet?

Student: Yes, it's all about my rights in the USA. It has 6 subpoints in it.

Officer: Your visa is approved.

Student: Thanks, have a nice day!

Student: Good morning!

Officer: How are you?

Student: I am doing well, thanks.

Officer: Why do you want to go to the USA by this program?

Student: First of all, as an Access Microscholarship Program alumna, each year we celebrated “4th of July”. And we had a lot of fun. We’ve once made a barbecue. This program is a great opportunity to feel that atmosphere with American people. Secondly, the city which I am going is Nashville, the music city. Even I don’t have a voice, I adore singing a song. I guess I’ll visit concerts and music festivals there. (I told it very quickly, cause she looked like she is in a hurry.)

Officer: Where do you study?

Student: I am currently studying at university of Turan-Astana. My major is Translation studies. I am a third year student.

Officer: What do your parents do?

Student: My father is retired. He used to work as a lawyer. My mom is a librarian at local college.

Officer: Did you read this? (shows the pamphlet)

Student: Yes, of course!

Officer: Great. Your visa is approved.

Student: Thanks, have a nice day!

Officer: Hello, what is your name?

Student: Hello! My name is Murat Yelmazhanov.

Officer: Where do you study and what is your major?

Student: I am currently studying at Nazarbayev University and my major is Computer Science.

Officer: What do your parents do?

Student: My parents are entrepreneurs, we have a family business.

Officer: Tell me little about your family business.

Student: Our business specializes in the sale and installation of water purification filters throughout Astana. We offer a range of filters suitable for both household and commercial use, installing them in various locations including cafes, restaurants, schools, and more.

Officer: Looks like you have been to US last year, how was it?

Student: It was great, I spend 3 amazing months working and traveling around United States.

Officer: Wonderful! Where did you work and where are you going this year?

Student: I worked as a crew member at Five Guys in Rehoboth Beach, Delaware. It was a great experience of working in American fast-food chain. Now, I am going to Harwich city in Massachusetts, my employer in Dunkin Donuts is waiting for me.

Officer: Nice! Do you know your rights?

Student: Yes, of course!

Officer: Okay, your visa is approved!

Student: Thank you! Have a good day!

Officer: Where do you study?

Student: I am a full time student at Westminster International University in Tashkent in the second course.

Officer: What is your major?

Student: My major is business and management...

Officer: Tell me about your job offer

Student: My job offer is from Mount Olympus which is located in Wisconsin state, Wisconsin dells city, my position is going to be front desk in a hotel.

Officer: Do you have relatives in US?

Student: Yes, I have my uncle in US, he won a green card about 7 years ago..

Officer: (typing..) Sorry, i cannot approve your visa.

Неуспешные кейсы интервью (Reject)

Officer: Why you do want to participate in Work and Travel program?

Student: The reason why I want to participate in work and travel program is to explore new cultures, meeting new friends and get some international experience in terms of overseas.

Officer: When will you graduate?

Student: I will graduate in 2024 as far I have started in 2020

Officer: Great, what will you do after graduation?

Student: After graduation i want to open my own consulting agency, as far as my brother works in the same industry and runs a business, I want to join to him and run business together.

Officer: What do you mean by consulting agency?

Student: This is the agency where students are prepared for universities, and send them abroad .

Officer: Do they send students to America as well?

Student: No, only Europe and Malaysia.

Officer: Okay, what do your parents do for living?

Student: My parents are doctors.. (and other details explained)

Officer: What particularly you want to see in USA?

Student: I would like to visit places such as Chicago, Florida, Los angeles, because it is was my dream to see this places in reality that I have seen in TV.

Officer: Do you have any family members in USA?

Student: Yes, I have two far relatives in USA, first one is my grandmother, but right now she is Tashkent, second one (told all info, because it was mentioned in DS-160 when I applied for touristic visa)

Officer: Which visa is your grandmother got?

Student: She got a touristic visa

Officer: How long your grandma been in USA?

Student: She been to USA for six months, a month ago she came back to Uzbekistan.

Officer: Okay, I cannot approve your visa, you can read in this paper...

Visa Officer: Can you tell me about your current studies and how they relate to your Work and Travel plans?

Student: I'm studying at the Kazakh British Technical University... um, it's not directly related, but I think... experiencing a new culture... could be beneficial?

Visa Officer: How do you plan to finance your stay in the USA?

Visa Officer: Do you have any relatives or friends in the USA?

Visa Officer: It's important to have a clear purpose and plan for your participation in the Work and Travel program. Unfortunately, based on this interview, I'm not convinced of your intentions or preparation for this program. I'm sorry, but at this time, I cannot approve your visa application.
